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How can a neuropsychological evaluation be helpful in the clinical management of adult/geriatric patients?

- Characterize current cognitive and emotional functioning with the use of well-established standardized assessment instruments
- Clarify diagnosis and help differentiate between conditions (e.g. dementia versus depression; assist with dementia subtyping)
- Allow for the continued monitoring of cognitive functioning, particularly in cases of mild cognitive impairment or chronic underlying medical/neurological conditions
- Provide recommendations regarding treatment planning, medication, further medical testing, driving ability, academic accommodations, and general daily functioning, as well as include specific behavioral modifications or compensatory strategies that may assist with cognition and mood

Common referral questions:

- Subtyping dementia (e.g. vascular, Alzheimer's, mixed dementia, Parkinson's, FTD, LBD, etc.)
- Differentiating between psychiatric and neurological conditions (e.g. depression/anxiety versus dementia, sequelae of concussion versus persisting neuropsychiatric symptoms, etc.)
- Establishing a cognitive baseline when there are concerns about early dementia or if there is another diagnosed progressive condition with neurological/psychiatric/cognitive symptoms
- Characterizing cognitive functioning following an injury to the brain (e.g. post-stroke, TBI, concussion, etc.)
- Assess for ADHD/learning disabilities/intellectual disabilities
